

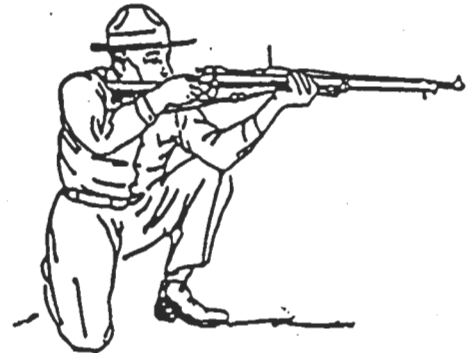

Subject: Final Results of the Marine Corps League National Pistol And Rifle Competition.

1. This past year with all the bad weather and floods, many of the east coast Detachments could not enter the 2004 competition and in the west they had forest fires again. We hope the coming year will work out better for our marksman.
2. If you notice the winner's rosters for the pistol and rifle we have many areas where there is no competition. On the Master rifle roster members that had previously competed could have won trophies if they would have entered this years matches. A member does not have to be a high master shooter to win a trophy.
3. The program is set up so any member of the Detachment or Units that cannot field a team and is interested in entering the competition can register as an individual and be eligible for a trophy. First time competitors will be classified as a MASTER for the current match, after firing they will be classified according to the score fired. This classification will be used for any of the matches entered in the future. All NRA classification will be honored upon submitting a zerox copy of the classification card.
4. The scores and classifications in this postal match have been reviewed by the committee and the selections, as determined by the committee are final. There will be no contesting of the committee's selections of the classification and awards.
5. The awards will be presented at the Falls Church Staff meeting . They can be picked up by the Detachment or unit receiving the award or by the Department or Detachment Commandant in attendance for distribution to the Detachment or individual recipient. The trophies that are not claimed at the Staff Meeting will be mailed to the Detachment or Unit of team Captain.
6. This year 2005 the Young Marine Units can enter also a handicap class will be honored arrangements can be made by contacting the Chairman at the number listed below.
7. If any name or other designation in the brochure is misspelled please contact the office of Ernest J. Simmons to make the corrections as soon as possible but no later than 25 January 2005. Name corrections will not be made after the trophies are engraved.

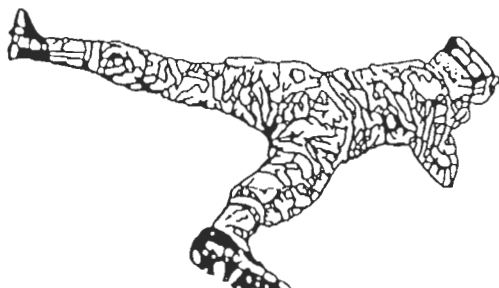

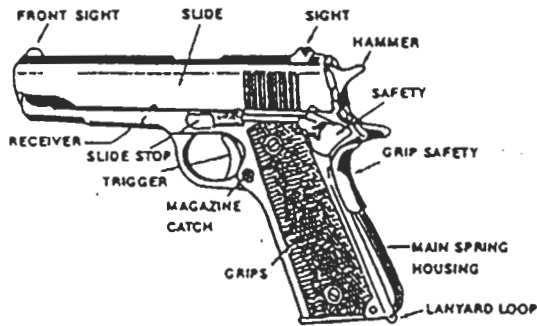

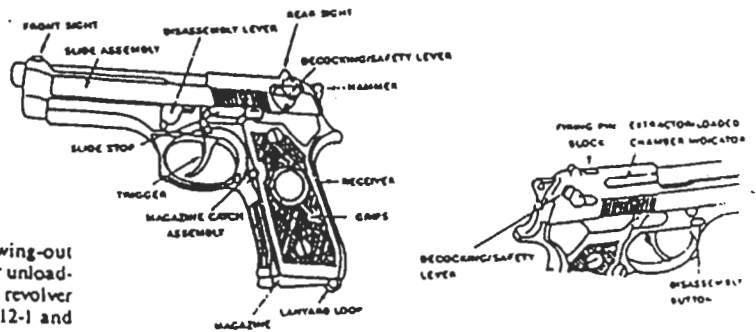
M1911A1 .45 Caliber Pistol

The M1911A1 .45 caliber pistol is a semiautomatic, magazine-fed, recoil-operated, single-action pistol.



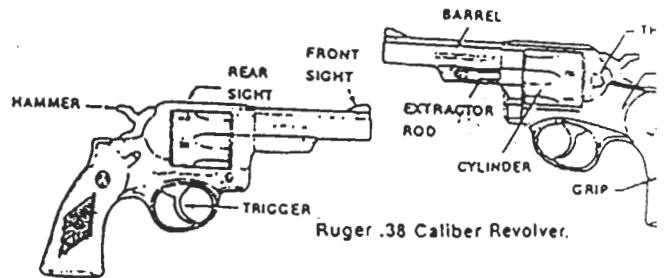
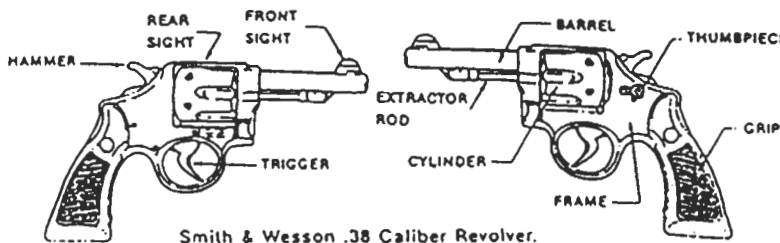
the M9 Pistol

The M9 is a 9mm, semiautomatic, magazine-fed, recoil-operated, double-action pistol. The magazine release button and decocking/safety lever are ambidextrous.



the .38 Caliber Revolver

The .38 caliber revolver is a cylinder-fed, double-action pistol. The swing-out cylinder has six chambers and a hand-operated extractor and ejector for unloading. Currently, the Marine Corps fields six variations of the .38 caliber revolver using two manufacturers—Smith & Wesson and Ruger. See figures 12-1 and 12-2.

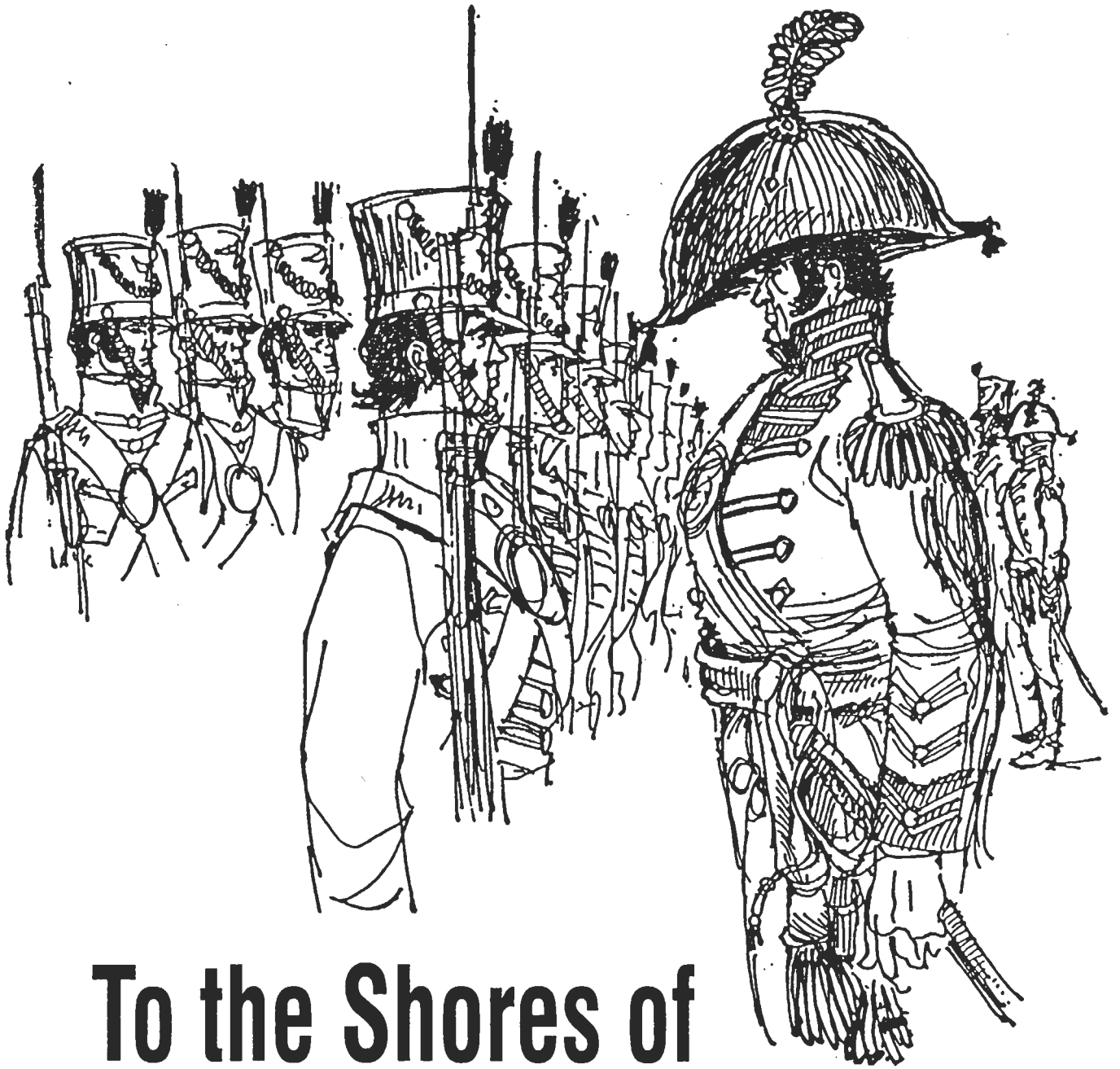
